Q: What types of doors do you install?

A: We specialize in entry doors, patio doors, interior doors and storm doors.

Q: How secure are the doors you install?

A: These doors are secure! For exterior doors, a 20 gauge security plate is used to help prevent kick-ins. The hardware used is heavy-duty and there are many different lock options.

Most importantly, our experienced installers will install the door to the highest standards. A poorly installed door is a security risk.
